The CPA Bulletin is produced by a small team who are closely involved with CPA activities. It frequently runs to 48 pages - typically 24 pages are editorial, of which 75% is original material written by CPA staff especially for the Bulletin.













THE IMPORTANCE OF THE CONSTRUCTION-PLANT HIRE SECTOR TO THE

UK ECONOMY

In 2024, the CPA commissioned Oxford Economics to research and write a report into the size and scope of the plant-hire sector in the UK. This is the first fully comprehensive study of the UK's plant-hire sector.

Entitled 'The Economic Impact of the UK Construction

Plant-hire Sector', the report makes a compelling read for
companies operating in the sector, but also for policymakers
and stakeholders. It also helps put into perspective the breadth
and scope of the sector and why it remains a key destination for
highly skilled jobs and roles.

KEY FINDINGS OF THE CPA/OXFORD ECONOMICS REPORT INCLUDE:

- The construction plant-hire sector contributes
 £14 billion annually to the UK economy
- Construction plant-hire contributes 191,500 jobs to the UK economy
- For every £100 contributed to GDP directly by construction plant-hire, the sector supports a total of £218 around the economy
- Construction plant-hire workers are 16% more productive than the average UK worker, with a higher share being company managers or directors
- For every 100 people directly employed by construction plant-hire, the sector supports a total of 216 jobs around the economy










