Braking Stopping Distances

 Manufacturers have confirmed that under the new STGO regulations all cranes conforming to the new axle loading and tyre speed category's will meet the braking stopping distances.

Chassis Maintenance

Manufacturers will supply an addendum to the operators manual with specific emphasis on the requirements of increased maintenance as a consequence of increased axle loading.

Operation of Mobile Cranes on the Highways

• All vehicles to be weighed in travelling order.
Running ballast/hook blocks,folding jibs,nylon reaction mats,timber supports,lifting equipment,full tank of fuel etc.

Operation of Mobile Cranes on the Highways

- Information should be supplied to the Crane Manufacturers.
- Manufactures to supply a plate to be displayed on the crane.
- Manufacturers to be contacted regarding cranes outside of specific categories.

Operation of Mobile Cranes on the Highways

A plate will be produced showing the category that the crane has been classified under.

"This is to be securely fixed to the mobile crane in a conspicuous and readily accessible position".
